Rev Up the Disability Vote National Disability Voter Registration Week

The <u>Wisconsin Disability Vote Coalition</u> invites you to join us as we participate in National Disability Voter Registration Week (NDVRW), September 13-20, 2021. NDVRW is a national, nonpartisan campaign to register, educate, and prepare voters with disabilities to vote in upcoming elections.

Only 17.7 million of the over 38 million eligible voters with disabilities participated in the 2020 elections. Despite an increase in voter turnout overall, in 2020 the <u>turnout rate</u> of voters with disabilities was 7% lower than voters without disabilities. We continue to hear from Wisconsinites with disabilities about the barriers they experience including poor access to transportation, inaccessible polling places, lack of acceptable photo ID, and limited awareness about voting rights and accommodations on the part of voters and poll workers.
