

## Wisconsin's Outstanding Caregiver Awards

Nominations accepted through February 28, 2023.

The Wisconsin State Conference Planning Committee invites nominations recognizing Wisconsin's outstanding caregivers. Awards recognize individuals living with the disease, family caregivers, organizations, and professionals who serve and support individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. Nominations must be submitted by **February 28, 2023**. Winners will be notified by email by March 15, 2023 and recognized at the 37th Annual Wisconsin State Conference Awards Ceremony the night of May 21, 2023, which will be held at the Wilderness Resort in Wisconsin Dells, WI.

### Courage Award

Recognizes an individual currently living with memory loss who is a role model for others through exemplifying support, education, advocacy and facing challenges.

### Family Caregiver Award

Recognizes an individual or family who embodies the courage to face the challenges of caregiving, the compassion to ensure dignity for their loved one, and the wisdom to reach out for support.

### Professional Award

Recognizes an individual or individuals who bring to his/her profession a dedication that serves as a model to others in this field. Includes nursing assistants, home care workers, nurses, therapists, administrators, clergy, social workers, and other related disciplines.

### Selection Criteria

Nominee must make an exceptional contribution related to services, caregiving and/or advocacy to improve the lives of individuals with Alzheimer's and/or their families.

Cannot be self-nominated.

All nominations will be verified for accuracy.

Alzheimer's Association employees are not eligible for nominations. Nominations of couples, individuals, or groups are welcomed.

Winners plus one (1) guest will attend the awards presentation as guest(s) of the Alzheimer's Association.

Winners will be asked to submit a photo.
