



Yosemite National Park is hiring GIS assistants through the Scientists in Park program









Five positions are open within Yosemite’s Resources Management and Science division.

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or U.S. legal permanent resident
- Must be 18 years or older
- Must be able to pass a federal background check
- Must not have served 4 previous AmeriCorps terms
