MDOC NIGHT STREET LEAGUE – SERIES 12 With A events completed, we have reached

With 4 events completed, we have reached the mid-point of our 12th season of NSL events. Overall league tables for gross points and handicap scores are now available on the MDOC website. There are some familiar names in and around the leading positions, but with 4 events still to go, there are plenty of opportunities to boost your scores (and, with your best 4 scores counting, you could still win the league – even if you have not started yet!). The second half kicks off on the 16th of January in the flatlands of Urmston, soon followed by a significant milestone in NSL history. The event on February 1st will be our 100th NSL event, and we are returning to the scene of our first – held in Marple in October 2011. The venue has changed but the planner (John Britton) remains the same. Look out for a classic NSL event – possibly with a couple of surprises.

We move on via Handforth, to our final league event of the season which is on a new area, encompassing parts of Mottram, Hattersley and Godley.

Prize giving will take place at our Cup Final event in early March. Competition on the night is for the Hydrant trophy. A fiendishly complicated handicap system ensures that anyone who has competed on a reasonably regular basis throughout the season has a chance of lifting the trophy!
